n March 19, 1987, G-d spoke into my spirit that judgment was at the door of America. Then on March 24, 1987, as I was praying in our house of prayer in Washington DC overlooking the Supreme Court Capitol. God took me into a trance. It seemed as if eternity was at my feet. Bombs were going off over our heads. In the vision, I reached for the phone to call someone and warn them, but it was too late. Suddenly, I found myself praying against the powers of Communism and Islam. Then eternity seemed to vanish before me. Afterwards, a still small voice in my spirit said: "Severe judments are coming on America soon, but I am holding them back briefly because the Jews have not been adequately warned to return to Israel."

A mandate was given to me by the Lord to "Blow a Trumpet in

Zion" and "Sound an Alarm" throughout America in love, warning the Jewish people to immediately return to Israel. Also, I was instructed to encourage the Christian Zionists in America to pray for, to warn and to help the Jewish people return to their promised land. Cindy Jacobs just prophesied that this word from the Lord is for this time, 2020.

Shortly after that, David Wilkerson, pastor of Times Square Church & Teen Challenge, also warned of financial shakings, plagues, and biological and nuclear attacks.

On October 1, 1987, I wrote the book, *Let My People Go!* from this vision and the same month, we began Jerusalem House of Prayer for All Nations on the Mount of Olives. We have been praying 24/7 for the return of Jews to Israel for 33 years now.

We mailed the first edition of this book, *Let My People Go!*, to 12,000 Jewish leaders in 1988. G-d told me to warn the Jews in USA. Fifteen years later, in 2003, we mailed 550,000 copies of this book to Jewish leaders in USA, after 9/11 when the Twin Towers in New York fell. After the 2008 stock market crash in New York, we continued to pray 24/7 for Aliyah. We hope to do another mailing, even larger, 700,000 copies in the last quarter of 2020, to warn the American Jews to come home to Israel before it is too late.

In Russia, we conducted Jericho Marches around the Kremlin Red Square each year for 7 years, and we saw over 1.3 million Jews come to Israel from Russia in the decade of 1986-1995.

Beginning from 2013-2019, for 7 years, we began doing a yearly Aliyah Prayer Tour to the USA during Passover for 8-10 days to the 12 largest Jewish Communities throughout the USA which included Los Angeles, Chicago, Miami, Washington DC, Virginia, Maryland, Philadelphia, New Jersey, New York City, Boston, Toronto (Canada), and all over Europe. G-d showed us many things to break and proclaim in prayer for the return of the Jews to Israel.

On April 12, during Passover 2020, on the Feast of Firstfruits, in the worst time of the Covid-19 pandemic in Brooklyn, New York City, in our 8th year, a time of repentance and new beginnings, we

began a 24/7 "Ark of His Presence" Aliyah House of Prayer in New York City for the breakthrough of Aliyah from New York City and the West. There, they proclaim the 700 Scriptures on Aliyah every day and encourage the Jews to come home!

I believe this could be the last warning, as over 10,000 Jews recently lost their lives from Covid-19 in the New York City area, throughout the USA, and in the largest Jewish cities and nations of Europe. Why was New York City, USA hit so hard when it is the most advanced and developed nation in the world? Could it be that G-d is beginning to unravel the United States as He did the former Soviet Union from 1986-1995, because it is His appointed time to bring the Jews home to Israel? If this is G-d's appointed time, He may very well be using the Covid-19 pandemic to prepare the Jews from the USA and the Western nations to turn their eyes toward Jerusalem to come home to their Promised Land, Israel.

G-d's Word will not return void. It will accomplish what He has purposed. 700 Scriptures are calling the Jews home. His appointed time is here.

I believe this coming season is the last before much greater shakings and this season could be the last opportunity for the Jews to come home with their finances in a "normal way" before things become much worse. He says in the book of Haggai that He will shake everything that can be shaken.

2020: ALIYAH AS A PARADIGM SHIFT INTO A NEW SEASON

A paradigm shift into the new season of 2020 is that Jerusalem and Israel will take a greater prominence for Jewish people globally, Aliyah from the US and the West will increase significantly, and more Jewish people will receive their King.

We're seeing amazing things happening in these days. We've seen shaking in the largest Jewish city in the world, New York City, where over 2 million Jewish people live in the New York City area. There are more Jewish people in the whole area of greater New York City than in the seven largest Jewish cities in Israel, if you can

imagine. G-d is shaking New York. He's shaking major Jewish areas like France, Belgium, UK, Germany, Italy, Brazil, Argentina, Canada, USA, and even Australia. Most major Jewish areas of the world are being shaken. What is happening? The Jewish people in those nations are realizing that the Jews in Israel — the secular Jews, the orthodox Jews, the Zionist Jews, all different kinds of Jews — are being taken care of better in Israel than they are in the nations. In Israel, around 600 Jews died (so far, August 2020) from Covid-19, whereas in the nations where half the Jewish people still live, thousands of Jews that have lost their lives — ten thousand. So possibly 15 times more Jews have lost their lives in the nations through this virus than they have in Israel. Many Jews in the nations right now are saying we want to make Aliyah to Israel. In fact, many of the native born Israelis who have been living abroad for years — up to a 100 thousand — are moving back to Israel because they want to be back in Israel, their homeland and the homeland for all Jews. They know it's their homeland and they want to come home. Now many Jews — secular, Orthodox, and Zionist Jews all over the world — are saying, "We now want to make Aliyah to Israel." The Jewish Agency is saying that in the next year, they believe up to 100 thousand Jews could come home soon.

When I updated the book, Let My People Go! in January 2020 before all this happened, I felt the Lord show me that over a million Jewish people could come back from the western nations in the decade of the 2020's. With all that has been happening since then, it could even be more than a million. We knew that G-d has brought them from the north, south, and east, but this next season is the time for them to come back from the West, where 90% live outside Israel. He says in Hosea 11:10-11 that the Jewish people will come trembling from the West. I believe we're going to see them in this coming decade, come trembling from the West. Aliyah is going to grow in a very significant way from the western nations, because of the shakings that are taking place and will take place.

There are over 700 Scriptures in the back of this book, calling the Jewish people back to Israel. *Let My People Go!* is available through our ministry. Actually, almost a million and a half copies have gone

out globally. About 35 different languages are in print. In our 24/7 house of prayer in New York City, they are proclaiming day and night the 700 Scriptures about Aliyah to the Jews coming home to Israel. We are also doing this in Israel. People are joining in Korea and other nations, because we believe it's the time for G-d to honor His Word and we hope that the Jewish people will come back before greater shakings and judgments come. We know the fullness will come back. It says all Jews in the world will come back. In Ezekiel 39:27, it says, "I will bring them back, not leaving any behind." So they will come back like they came out of Egypt; none were left behind. Ultimately, all the Jews from New York City and all over the West will all be back in Israel according to the Word of G-d, spoken to the prophet Ezekiel. We know that Ezekiel was written after they came back out of Egypt, so obviously, he's not talking about them coming from Egypt in the book of Ezekiel.

There's another verse which is very strong on Aliyah from the book of Micah 2:12-13. It says, "I will surely gather all of you, Jacob. I will surely bring together the remnant of Israel. I will bring them together like sheep in a pen, like a flock in His pasture. The place will throng with people." This is talking about Israel. Here's an interesting Scripture. "The One Who breaks open the way will go up before them." G-d is calling intercessors to stand with Him in "breaking open the gates" of New York City, "breaking open the gates" of the Jewish communities in the USA, Europe, and in the world to see the Jewish people return to Israel. It says, "They will break through the gates and go out, their King at their head." I believe largely because of the intercessors praying and G-d shaking things. The Jews will come back to Israel!

We know that anti-Semitism has been increasing in major ways — mostly in the western world where 95% of the Jews outside of Israel live today. These are the hunters who are arising, as the fishermen are fishing, and we know that now is the time. In New York City, just before this virus sprang up, from Hanukkah to the beginning of January, there were ten major incidents of anti-Semitism all over New York City, and it's only increasing today. So, we know G-d is

speaking — not only through this corona virus, but also through the anti-Semitism that's been rising all over the Western world.

Micah 2:13 b says, "The King will pass through before them, the Lord at their head." The King of the Jews is going to pass before them. He is leading them back to Israel. It says He will pass before them and the Lord will be at their head. So this Aliyah is being initiated by the Lord Himself Who is longing for His people to come back to His land and come to their Messiah, and to be prepared for the coming of the King of Glory. We thank G-d for what He's doing through the shakings. I believe the shakings that G-d is bringing are redemptive shakings for the following purposes:

- the fullness of His redemptive purpose to happen through these shakings
- the fullness of His redemptive purpose for us to repent, humble ourselves, seek His face, turn from our wicked ways
- the fullness of His redemptive purpose for us to walk in the fear of the Lord and to walk in the holiness of the Lord
- the fullness of His redemptive purpose for Israel to come to the fullness of their focus and purpose
- the Jews to turn their eyes to Jerusalem, and away from New York City, away from France, away from LA, away from Miami, away from Great Britain, away from Germany to think upon Jerusalem.

It's time for them to come home, because the 700 Scriptures are calling them home, and the Lord at their head is passing before them back to the land of Israel.

We also know, according to the Word of G-d and based on statistics, Israel is by far the safest place in the world for the Jewish people. In the last eighty years, 99% of all the Jews that were killed were killed outside of Israel. Only 20,000 were killed in the wars of Israel. Even now, outside of Israel, many more Jews are dying from the corona virus than those living in Israel. Israel is by far the safest place for them. Even abortion statistics estimate approximately six

million Jews were killed outside of Israel, while many less were killed inside of Israel. In Israel, you have the largest families in the Western Hemisphere, in the industrialized world. The average household in Israel has 3.5 children in every household. Even among the secular Jews, in Israel, they have a higher birth rate than in the industrialized nations all over the world. We thank G-d that family life is among the best in Israel of any place in the world. We thank G-d for the strong family unit in Israel. It is of note that according to recent statistics, Israelis, with all the challenges they have with the surrounding nations, remain the most optimistic people in the world.

The health system in Israel is great. I was in the hospital for ten days in intensive care. As an Israeli citizen, I didn't have to pay even one shekel. Had I been in the USA, it could have cost me \$100,000. The Jews in the West know that the health system in Israel is great, which is another reason they are desiring to come back to Israel.

Jewish education around the world is very expensive in the United States and other countries. But praise G-d, in Israel, you don't have to pay for education. We know that Israel is also called to be a light to the nations. We believe that through the shakings that are happening, that righteousness will be restored to Israel. They will trust in their Messiah and they will be redeemed, and they will turn away from abortions in Israel, from ungodly sexuality, from all the other evils of our society. G-d promises in Zechariah 8 that He will make this nation of Israel a holy nation. He will shake the nation until the nation becomes a holy nation, until we trust in the Bible when we look to the Lord, the G-d of Israel, and turn from our wicked ways. G-d is going to purify the sons of Levi according to the Word of G-d.

I believe that G-d wants to bring home all Jewish people, but He especially wants to bring home the younger generation of Jews from all over the world, those under the age of forty. Those that can invest the best part of their lives — thirty, forty, fifty, sixty, seventy years of their life — standing for the nation of Israel, investing into Israel and investing the best years of their lives in Israel, trusting in the G-d of Israel, and preparing the way for the coming of the Messiah, the King of Glory.

This is what the Lord Almighty says: "Once again men and women of ripe old age will sit in the streets of Jerusalem, each of them with cane in hand because of their age. The city streets will be filled with boys and girls playing there." Zechariah 8:4-5

We see that G-d is working in amazing ways. He says that He will not come back until the Lord builds up Zion, then He will appear in His glory (see Psalm 102:16). So, we know that building up Zion, the Jews coming back to Israel, and coming back to their G-d is preparing the way for the coming of the King of glory.

The superior management of the coronavirus outbreak in Israel, while we felt stranded and abandoned by state policies, will never disappear. Haredi Jews in Brooklyn and Rockland County who had seen tens of deaths a day for the past [months] will never again be able to look down on Israel.

Jewish Student Unions Call on Israel to Bring Remaining Ethiopian Jews [Home] $^{[I]}$

The World Union of Jewish Students (WUJS) called on the Israeli government to bring the remaining Ethiopian Jews to Israel at the Union's annual Congress this week. Over 40 international Jewish student unions were represented at the Congress.

Baye Alemye, who attended the Congress, was the first ever representative of the Ethiopian Jewish community. Baye is the cantor of the Tikvat Zion Synagogue in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia and his community is still waiting to make Aliyah to Israel.

"Every Jew from all around the world can easily make Aliyah," said Baye, according to a WUJS press release. "Israel has open borders for any Jew who wants to return home, yet this does not seem to be true for Ethiopian Jews."

"We, as global Jewish youth, believe that we need to stand strong and united against injustice. It is our duty to advocate for this community in order for them to return to the Jewish homeland and reunite with their families," said the WUJS in the press release.

(The new minister of Aliyah in Israel in 2020 is an Ethiopian. I

Will American Jews seize or miss a third opportunity to make Aliyah and make a big difference for themselves & Israel at this appointed time in the 2020's?

(The USA Jewish Community missed two opportunities to make a difference. May they not miss a third opportunity in the 2020's.)

A.B. Yehoshua, an Israeli author, gave a controversial speech in 2006 to the American Jewish Committee in Washington where he essentially said that <u>Jews in the Diaspora were play acting at being Jews</u>, and that the only place where a genuinely full and natural Jewish life was possible was in Israel.

Those words – understandably – antagonized many and stirred controversy both in Israel and the US, and a few months later Yehoshua wrote a piece explaining himself.

"After Palestine was taken over by the British, the Balfour Declaration of 1917 promised a national home for the Jews, and if during the 1920s, when the country's gates were open wide, just a half million (US) Jews had come (less than 5 percent of the Jewish people at that time) instead of the tiny number that actually did come, it certainly would have been possible to establish a Jewish state before the Holocaust on part of the Land of Israel," he wrote.

"This state not only would have ended the Israeli-Arab conflict at an earlier stage and with less bloodshed – it also could have provided refuge in the 1930s to hundreds of thousands (*if not a million or more*) of Eastern European Jews who sensed the gathering storm, and thus would have significantly reduced the number of victims in the Holocaust."

Looking at the relatively small number of Jews who immigrated to Israel from the United States since the founding of Israel (*less than 200,000 in over 72 years*), one can ask a similar question. What would this country look like today, what would conflict with the Palestinians look like, if in the decade after 1967 Six Day War (*from 1967-1977 instead of the less than 40,000 who came to Israel in this decade*), one-tenth of American Jews, or 600,000 people, would have made Aliyah?

But it wasn't to be. Actually, immigration from the US peaked in the aftermath of the Six Day War, numbering 7,158 in 1971, before leveling off at some 3,000 a year in the aftermath of the 1973 Yom Kippur War.

The number of US olim from 1968 to 2002, when Aliyah promotion NGO Nefesh B'Nefesh started to operate, was some 2,774 a year. Since Nefesh B'Nefesh has been active, that number has grown to an average of 3,125 a year, meaning that Nefesh B'Nefesh has made immigration easier, but has not turned the drizzle of immigration from the US into a flood.

May the US and Western Jewish community finally get it and not miss this 3rd opportunity in the 2020's to receive their inheritance in Israel to make their life count and make a big difference and be blessed and be a big blessing in Israel, the land of their fathers – Deuteronomy 28 – as those before them could have in the 1920's and 30's and 1960's and 70's. We pray that millions of Jews will return to Israel in the 2020's and settle in Judea, Samaria, and the cities of Israel to greatly bless G-d and to strengthen the heartland and whole land of Israel for the future, to prepare the way for the coming of Messiah, the King of Glory.

"You will arise and have compassion on Zion, for it is time to show favor to her; the appointed time has come...The nations will fear the name of the Lord, all the kings of the earth will revere Your glory." (Psalm

102:13&15)

"Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the (King) rises upon you." (Isaiah 60:1)

"Lift up your eyes and look about you: All assemble and come to you; your sons come from afar (USA), and your daughters are carried on the hip." (Isaiah 60:4)

As the Jews came swiftly from Egypt 4,000 years ago and other times in history, and 25-30 years ago they came swiftly from Russia and the Former Soviet Union, so they will again come swiftly, as G-d is shaking and will contine to shake the USA and the Western nations.

Approximately six and a half million Jews were killed in the last 80 years — over 99% of them were killed outside of Israel.

Jeremiah 30 says He will bring them from the land of their exile — 80% of the Jews outside of Israel today are in the USA. Over one million Jews came to Israel from the Former Soviet Union from 1986-1995. I believe in the decade of the 2020's over a million Jews could make Aliyah to Israel from the USA, the Americas, and Europe. It's the appointed time to stand in the gap in prayer and helping financially for the breakthrough to make Aliyah to Jerusalem. I asked the Lord why anti-Semitism is rising even more under President Trump's administration, the most Pro-Israel president ever, than when Obama was in office. The impression I received from the Lord is that G-d is allowing the hunters to arise, because this is the appointed time for Aliyah from the US and the West to Israel. Since 2015, anti-Semitism in the US has been strongly increasing, and Aliyah is also beginning to rise.

The place the corona virus affected the most in the USA in March-June 2020 was New York City, the "Big Apple" (and its metro area, New Jersey), the epicenter of the CoVid-19 pandemic where

over 50,000 people died — many of them Jews — almost half of all the U.S. and 10% of all who died in the planet. This is where over 2 million Jews live — over 15% of all the Jews in the world, with more Jews living in New York than the seven largest Jewish cities of Israel: Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, Haifa, Ashdod, Rishon LeZiyyon, Petah Tikva, and Netanya. Could it be that G-d is beginning to initiate circumstances in New York City, in the USA and the Western world to bring the Jews home, as He shakes everything, just as He did in Russia and the former Soviet Union in the 1980's and 90's?

In Europe, three of the five most affected nations were the three largest Jewish communities: France, UK, and Germany. In Ezekiel 39:28, G-d says, "I will gather them to their own land [Israel], not leaving any behind." This is another sign that it is time for the Jews to come home to Israel.

The prophet, Zechariah, said, "<u>On that day the LORD will shield</u> those who live in Jerusalem, so that the feeblest among them will be like David, and the house of David will be like G-d, like the angel of the LORD going before them." (Zechariah 12:8)

"'So do not be afraid, Jacob my servant; do not be dismayed, Israel,' declares the Lord. 'I will surely save you out of a distant place (USA), your descendants from the land of their exile. Jacob will again have peace and security, and no one will make him afraid. I am with you and will save you,' declares the Lord. 'Though I completely destroy all the nations, among which I scatter you [the USA is not clearly mentioned in the end-time scenario], I will not completely destroy you. I will discipline you [Israel] but only in due measure; I will not let you go entirely unpunished.' (Jeremiah 30:10-11)

"But you, mountains of Israel, will produce branches and fruit for my people Israel, for they will soon come home. I am concerned for you and will look on you with favor; you will be plowed and sown, and I will cause many people to live on you—yes, all of Israel. The towns will be inhabited and the ruins rebuilt. I will

increase the number of people and animals living on you, and they will be fruitful and become numerous. I will settle people on you as in the past and will make you prosper more than before. Then you will know that I am the Lord. I will cause people, my people Israel, to live on you. They will possess you, and you will be their inheritance; you will never again deprive them of their children. (Ezekiel 36:8-12)

"I am the (King); in (the appointed) time I will do this swiftly (from the West)." (Isaiah 60:22)

During CoVid-19, 10,000 Jews died in the USA and Western nations from March-August 2020 and only 600 in Israel even though the number of Jews living in Israel were similar to those living in Western nations.

"I am the (King); in (the appointed) time I will do this swiftly (suddenly from the West)." (Isaiah 60:22)

Between a great increase of anti-Semitism, the Covid-19 devastation in New York City, USA — being hit worse than any nation — and the racial riots in August 2020, shaking the society and economy, the USA hangs in the balance. The terrible killing of George Floyd, an Afro-American, was a spark that ignited racial violence and Marxist anarchy across the cities of America. All that has been happening has increased the desire for many Jews to make Aliyah. Unless radical repentance happens and the USA fully stands with Israel and stops pushing a Palestinian state, the shaking will continue. As much as Trump has helped Israel, the fulfillment of his Cyrus anointing and his re-election could be in great jeopardy if he pushes a Palestinian state dividing Israel The USA very well could be also divided.

"and say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: I will take the Israelites out of the nations where they have gone. I will gather them from all around and bring them back into their own land. I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel. There will be one king over all of them and they will never again be two nations or be divided into two kingdoms." (Ezekiel 37:21-22 NIV)

[&]quot;For behold, in those days and at that time, when I

bring back the captives of Judah and Jerusalem, I will also gather all nations, and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat; and I will enter into judgment with them there on account of My people, My heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations; they have also divided up My land." (Joel 3:1-2 NKJV)

Is it possible that God is unraveling the USA as He did in Russia and the Former Soviet Union 30 years ago to fulfill the 700 Scriptures on Aliyah to bring the Jews home to Israel from the USA and the West as He did from Russia, to prepare the way for the King of Glory to come to Jerusalem?

Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the people of Israel; so hear the word I speak and give them warning from me. (Ezekiel 33:7)

God says He will send famines, drought, locusts and plagues. Without deep repentance, America as we know it is history.

When I shut up the heavens so that there is no rain, or command locusts to devour the land or send a plague among my people, if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. (2 Chron. 7:13-14)

Americans need to repent for breaking the ten commandments, for moral impurity, abortion, materialism, pride/arrogance, not standing with Israel. What is happening in 2020 will only stop if we meet His conditions and humble ourselves praying and seeking His face and turning from our wicked ways. Only then will He hear our prayers and forgive our sins and heal our land. God can, in one day, destroy the Covid-19 virus if we meet His conditions.

While America has been a great blessing to the Jews for the last 200 years, whatever happens, this is His appointed time for the Jews to begin coming home to Israel.
